7. The school shall maintain section teacher ratio, at least 1:1.5 at each level i.e. Primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. Secondary (XI-XII)

SCHOOLS IN TWO SHIFTS

The school shall not run the classes in two shifts without the formal prior approval of the board.

Running of classes in two shifts may be allowed by the board subject to the following :-

- 15.3.1 The request of the school will be considered only after the permission has been obtained from the concerned State/UT Government for running classes in two shifts.
- 15.3.2 The permission for two shifts will be approved only after inspection of the school premises by a committee appointed by the board.
- 15.3.3 There should be separate set of teaching and non-teaching staff as per norms of CBSE for each shift including separate Head Master or Vice-Principal for supervision.
- 15.3.4 There should be separate school records such as admission register, attendance register etc. and separate staff rooms for the teachers of both the shifts.
- 15.3.5 Teaching hours shall be followed as per the scheme of studies of classes conducted in each shift and there should be a minimum gap of half an hour between both the shifts.
- 15.3.6 In general the school should run junior classes in the morning shift and senior classes in the evening shift. In case the school proposes to do otherwise, express permission for the same from the state government shall be obtained.
- 15.3.7 Fee as given in Appendix-I shall be charged from the school for permission of running in two shifts.

SHIFTING OF SCHOOL FROM ONE CAMPUS TO ANOTHER

The school shall run the classes only from the address/campus on which the affiliation was granted and shall not shift to any other address /campus without the formal prior approval of the board.

Shifting of school from one address/campus to another may be allowed by the board subject to the following :-



- The school is required to maintain FDR of reserve fund in the joint name of CBSE and Manager of the school as per provisions of Attendance.
- The School Managing Committee has not been constituted as per Attendance Board, therefore, it may be reconstituted by including 02 representatives of parents and CBSE. The school is also required to forward 5-6 names of nearby CBSE affiliated school (2-3 of them may be from KV's/NVs) to the Board as Board's nominees for inclusion in School Managing Committee.

Provisions of Affiliation bye laws for adherence:-

Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. **No capitation fee or voluntary donations** for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any unreasonable procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.

School should not use the activities for **commercialization**:-

- As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape or form.
- As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, logo and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be liable for commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.

Parents are to be made educated regarding **corporal punishment** & should avoid any physical involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).

School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from its affiliated school building/ premises.

Admission to the school is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination Bye Laws of the Board of Affiliation bye laws.

School has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its Judgment No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaska and other State of Rajasthan and other guidelines issued under rule no. 10.9.

School affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, else as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered by the employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix A of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.

Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with the Government. Further, **Salary and service conditions** of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-

"The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff as per the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per the guidelines prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10.2 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.

Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of joining of the teachers on probation.

9. Continuous [REDACTED] is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv).
10. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
11. Running of classes of [REDACTED] in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
12. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the [REDACTED].
13. [REDACTED] should be adequately equipped i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.6 and rule 23.11.
14. [REDACTED] conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
15. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own [REDACTED] containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.
16. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least [REDACTED] for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
17. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full-time basis for performing the duties of a [REDACTED] as per rule 8.6.
18. Strict adherence to the provisions of [REDACTED] while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
19. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of [REDACTED]. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescriptive books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.

4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
5. 6.
