Extra Curricular Activities

Admission Procedure

Registration for admission in school begins in January of the calendar year. Application for registration /admission must be submitted on the prescribed form available along with prospectus from school office during working days between 9.00.a.m to 2.00 p.m. For Admission to Nursery, Parents need to bring the child along with following Documents:

1. Photocopy of Birth Certificate.
2. Three Stamp size photographs of the child.
3. Passport size photograph of each of parents.
4. Aadhar Card of child, Mother and Father.

For those seeking admission in the classes other than nursery; photocopy of Marksheet or progress report of the class passed along with Transfer Certificate is required. Admission will be granted only after all the dues as applicable have been cleared. In all matters related to admission decision of the Principal will be final.

Dismissal:



Students admission can be terminated on any one of the following grounds.

1. Indiscipline.
2. Unsatisfactory progress in work.
3. Repeated detention in the same class.
4. Shortage of Attendance.
5. Any other reason that may not be considered conducive for the school.

WITHDRAWAL

1. Any child seeking withdrawal from the the school, an application must be filed in the Principal's office before 31st March of the year. In case no such notice is given, the student will be liable to pay a month tuition fee.
2. If a child is withdrawn, during the mid session six months fee will be charged.
3. Transfer Certificate will be issued when all the dues of the school are settled.



General Rules:

Parents are requested to get the Fee Payment schedule from the office for timely payment and to avoid inconvenience any delay in depositing the fee after the last date will lead to bear late fee fine/cancellation of admission.

Any kind of misbehaviour or misconduct even outside the school by the student will be the sufficient reasons for expulsion.

No child should bring money and expensive articles in school, The school will not be responsible for any loss or damage of any article.

Disciplinary action or fine will be imposed for causing damage to school property.

Students are not allowed to bring mobile in the school. Phone will be confiscated, and fine of Rs. 500/= will be imposed.
