

#### **Admission Procedure**

Registration for admission in school begins in January of each calendar year. Application for registration /admission must be submitted on the prescribed form available along with prospectus from school office during working days between 9.00.a.m to 2.00 p.m. For admission to Nursery, parents need to bring the child along with the following Documents:

- 1. Photocopy of Birth Certificate.
- 2. Three Stamp size photographs of the child.
- 3. Passport size photograph of each of the parents.
- 4. Aadhar Card of the child, mother and father.

For those seeking admission in the classes other than nursery, photocopy of Marksheet or progress report of the previous class passed along with Transfer Certificate is mandatary Admission will be granted only after all the dues, as applicable, have been cleared. In all matters related to admission, decision of the Principal will be final.







### **Parent-Teacher Meeting**

Parent-Teacher meeting is a regular feature of the school children parents/guardians avail this opportunity to discuss the progress of their children. Parents can meet the teachers on all working days with prior appointment, based on the availability of the teacher.





#### **House Allocation**

The whole school's strength is divided in four houses in the names of Chaar Sahibzadas of Guru Gobind Singh Ji for collective responsibility and solidarity.
